What level is best for you?

All motivated players with skills appropriate to the level listed are welcome. Peter's goal is to lead each attendee in attaining maximum improvement within their individual capabilities. Peter works on the premise that the more you understand, the more you will be able to do. This leads to greater enjoyment and music making.

Class Level Definitions

Level 1 – Ukulele Basics for the not so new beginner.

Play C, C7, F, G, G7, D7 chords.

Play a C scale (C, D, E, F, G, A, B, C) starting on the 3rd string, open C.

Comfortable playing and singing a few simple songs with a group.

Basic understanding of treble clef music notation.

Know the pitch names of the 4 open strings.

Level 2 – Ukulele fundamentals for the intermediate beginner.

Play standard chord progressions in keys C, D, F, G.

Understand the concept of I, IV, V7 chords in the keys of C, D, F, G:

In key of C C, F, G7

In key of D D, G, A7

In key of F F, Bb, C7

In key of G G, C, D7

Play C & F Major scales and know each pitch name.

Play simple melody lines by ear.

Play 3-chord songs without music.

Understand music notation and know note names on the treble staff.

Level 3 – Ukulele for the advanced enthusiast.

Play a rhythmic strum with the right hand while singing.

Play the I, vi, IV, V7, I chord progression in keys C, D, F, G:

In key of C C, am, F, G7

In key of D D, bm, G, A7

In key of F F, dm, Bb, C7

In key of G G, em, C, D7

Understand and play bar chords using the movable chord forms.

Common chord forms: C, C7, D, F, F7, G7, A, A7

Play C & F scales and know each pitch name.

Able to read music and play simple notated passages in C, F, and Bb Major.

Sing, Sing, Sing!

A singing class for all abilities, all levels. Learn to sing in tune and create harmony for a blended vocal sound. Peter puts the fun in the fundamentals of singing for pleasure.
